
Discover Botswana

Defined by the Kalahari Desert and the Okavango Delta, the country's dynamic ecosystem makes it an irresistible magnet to wildlife. This is where you'll find, for example, the world's largest population of elephants.

Across Botswana, from the lush wetlands of the extraordinary Okavango Delta – 10,000 square miles of floodplains, palm groves and papyrus swamps visible from space – to the swathes of shrubby savannah and swaying grasslands dotted with baobab trees, a thrilling array of animals finds sanctuary. Not just the "big five" of lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard and rhino, but hyena, warthog, the endangered Cape wild dog, black-backed jackals, bat-eared foxes, aardvarks, pangolins and a glorious wealth of amphibians, reptiles and birds.

Soak up this theatre of matchless drama from Belmond's three captivatingly different safari lodges, set in the Okavango Delta, Chobe National Park and Moremi Game Reserve. Connected to each other by light aircraft, together our spectacularly located retreats provide the ultimate Botswana safari experience.

Introducing Belmond Eagle Island Lodge

Set on remote Xaxaba Island, on the passage routes of many species, our lodge has long been the ideal base from which to explore the Okavango Delta

Recently re-imagined, the lodge's design captures the spirit of the delta, blending cleverly into the landscape while offering stylish and contemporary comforts. The wonders of nature take centre stage. A natural, earthy palette emphasises the delta's dazzling hues; views of the mesmerising landscape grace every room. Just like the water channels that weave their way through the grasslands, the design flows through the lodge. Delightful touches take inspiration from the wildlife – a swarm of metal butterflies hovers near the ceiling, wall textures echo elephant skin.

Your days promise to be filled with awe-inspiring adventures tailored to the season. When the delta's flooded, usually between May and October, the water wonderland is best explored by boat. In the drier months, activities include nature walks, village visits and an exhilarating horseback and helicopter safari.

As night falls, enjoy a sundowner in the bar, listening out for the fish eagle's distinct whistle. Or gather round the campfire for barbecued treats and the chance to swap stories with your fellow travellers.





Accommodation

Flooded with light by day, indulgently cosy at night, each of our 12 tented rooms is carefully positioned to afford total privacy and sweeping vistas

Unwind in soothing grey interiors, punctuated by flashes of deep gold. Stretch out on the oversized bed, framed by a stunning copper headboard that references Botswana's copper mining tradition.

Draped over the bed is a custom-made tulle mosquito net that plays with the lighting. Your bedside cabinets are integrated into the headboard, the traditional folding camp table is re-invented as a leather upholstered bench at the end of the bed and a separate daybed within a window nook doubles as a child's bed.

Discover the buckled leather minibar, inspired by an explorer's toolbox, and enjoy a desk, spacious walk-in closet and discreet air-conditioning.

In your luxurious bathroom you'll find an indoor and outdoor shower and a freestanding black bathtub. The floor is finished in a rippling water effect, copper taps suggest valves that open and close waterways and, at a glance, the bracketed bathroom lights might just be giant insects.

Then the final ta-da moment: step out onto your private deck and into your own plunge pool – a prime spot for soaking up the mesmerising scenery.

Spa Treatments



First Light Tours in partnership with Leica Sport Optics

Discover the Okavango Delta just as the sun rises and the breathtaking array of wildlife is waking up. Choose a guided dawn walk, canoe safari or helicopter flight, using a pair of powerful Leica binoculars to zoom in on thrilling detail. For a truly exceptional experience, book a private tour with leading wildlife photographer Marc Stickler. Tap into his extensive expertise to glean more about the area's wild inhabitants and how best to capture them on camera.

Mokoro Excursions

Glide silently on a dugout canoe, a traditional mode of transport used by locals for centuries, as you traverse shallow, clear waters past brilliant waterlilies and papyrus grasses, reaching areas inaccessible by boat. Glimpse brightly coloured frogs, kingfishers, dragonflies or elephants feasting on the reeds.

Powerboat Rides

These trips allow you to cover more ground, plunging deeper into the landscape and spotting a greater range of wildlife. Embark on a sunset barge cruise for mesmerising views as you sip a sundowner. (Not available in the dry season, usually November to March.)



Out & About

Nature Walks

During the drier months, enjoy a nature walk with a guide to learn more about the environment. Spot amazing sights close-up, including animal tracks and swarming termite mounds. Take time to appreciate the Little Five – elephant shrews, rhinoceros beetles, leopard tortoises, antlions and buffalo weaver birds.

Bird Watching

The region boasts a magnificent variety of birds - over 400 species make for unrivalled viewing. Keep an eye out for the rare Pel's fishing owl, endangered wattled crane and majestic African fish eagle.

Fishing

The delta's channels teem with tilapia, while spotted and silver catfish can be found in many lazy pools. African pike, infamous fighters, are a favourite snare. If you have never fished before, the Okavango Delta is the ultimate place to start. Please note: catch and release fishing only.

Village Visit

Visit our neighbouring Nxhoga village for an authentic insight into the Motswana way of life. Learn about mud, reed and can huts, meet the village elders, watch baskets being woven and purchase handicrafts to take home. There's a chance your Belmond guide hails from Nxhoga and will explain how the community has adapted ancient traditions to suit modern times.

Helicopter Safari

Flights over Botswana are one of life's big adventures. Soar high over the landscape, spotting remote, inaccessible lakes and islands as well as an abundance of wildlife.

Horseback and Helicopter Safari

This exhilarating safari begins early in the morning with a 10-minute helicopter flight. Then saddle up for a guided horseback ride through the delta, moving quietly past wild dog, elephant, buffalo, hippo and zebra in their natural habitat.

Introducing Belmond Savute Elephant Lodge

What makes our corner of Chobe National Park so special – apart from the large herds of elephant – is one of Northern Botswana's greatest mysteries

The enigmatic Savute Channel ebbs and flows seemingly at whim. When it sprang to life in 2011, after 30 years dormant, it turned the parched environment into a wetland paradise, attracting a huge array of wildlife.

This diversity – and the animal antics that go with it – have made Savute a hotspot for film and documentary makers. National Geographic's mini-series *Savage Kingdom* captured the way animals have adapted to the idiosyncratic environment, with leopards catching catfish in the muddy waters and wild dogs chasing impala into the river. Yet even when the waters recede, a network of waterholes means there are fascinating interactions to witness, as creatures including hyena, warthog and maribou storks all gather to slake their thirst.

Enjoy a ringside seat of the action from our tented oasis, newly redesigned to conjure up Savute's pioneering heritage – David Livingstone was among the explorers documenting wildlife here in the 19th century. Take breakfast overlooking the elephants at the watering hole or watch them from our new viewing hide. Embark on early-morning game drives or forays into the bush to see ancient San Bushmen paintings. Join us after dark for an uplifting boma. Your safari adventure begins here.

Accommodation

Belmond Savute Elephant Lodge boasts 12 luxurious tented rooms, each raised on a wooden platform to allow breathtaking views of animals in their natural habitat

As with the rest of the Lodge, handcrafted and bespoke pieces give the space a local, artisanal feel. Stretch out on your four-poster bed or the bright blue sofa facing out to the view. Your bedposts are inspired by the walking sticks of the San people or the elaborate, carved wooden posts of the Tuaregs who inhabit the Sahara Desert. Elegant draped mosquito nets keep unwanted visitors away. Above your coffee table hangs a blue and ivory-toned rope chandelier, creating dancing shadows at night. In the bathroom is a timber and marble vanity, housing pottery basins, and a generous outdoor shower connecting you to nature.

The expansive terrace serves as your glorious outdoor living space with a huge daybed taking centre stage. Inspired by African carved headrests, with a canopy that transforms it into a four-poster, it's a blissful spot for wildlife viewing, cocktail in hand.


Rooms are discreetly air-conditioned and include fully-stocked minibars and dressing rooms.



Wildlife Viewing Hide



At first light and dusk, animals including elephants, cheetahs, hyenas and antelope gather to drink, giving guests a front-row seat on nature's drama. At night the nocturnal sounds of Savute – roars, rumbles, chirps – are magically amplified

Spa Tent

Set in a secluded spot at the edge of the camp, our spatent offers tailored treatments using South African brand TheraNaka, which balances earthy scents and soothing herbs with ancient healing rituals. Choose our African Glow body treatment to be reinvigorated by rich marula and sandalwood, or replenish your skin's vitality with an After-Sun Wrap containing aloe ferox gel. We can also carry out treatments on your private deck if preferred.

Stargazing

The vast open spaces around Savute make it the perfect place to experience the immense, dark dome of the African night sky. Join one of our informal sessions round the fire, using powerful telescopes to witness constellations you may never have seen before. You'll also discover how Bushmen used the stars to locate the true south.

Embark on exciting game drives to encounter a wealth of wildlife or tailor a tour to your ornithological passions

Game Drives

Set off on early-morning and afternoon drives to encounter Africa's largest elephant population. You may also spot lions, wild dogs, leopards, cheetahs and hyenas, enjoy rare sightings of rock-climbing klipspringers and elegant roan and, depending on the season, catch the second largest migration of zebra in Africa.

Birdwatching

Savute is a bird-lovers' paradise, particularly in the summer months from December to March. Over 250 species populate the area, ranging from vast flocks of gregarious queleas to giant kori bustards and an array of majestic raptors. On a game drive, let your guide know if you're particularly interested in birds and they'll make sure you catch the best avian activity.

Bushmen Paintings and Baobab Trees

Join us on a journey into the bush, where rocks rear up among stony hills. Discover a collection of paintings that will take your breath away. These works by the San Bushmen are thought to be more than 1,500 years old - beautiful images of elephant, giraffe, sable and eland antelope. After admiring them, continue to the amazing baobab grove, a cathedral-like cluster of 13 giant trees that rival the Bushmen's paintings in age.

Introducing Belmond Khwai River Lodge

Animal magic meets old-world indulgence at one of the first lodges in Botswana to recognise the need for conservation

Launched in 1971, the original lodge eschewed hunting in favour of photographic safaris. It was set up by Harry Selby, a safari specialist who inspired one of Ernest Hemingway's fictional heroes. Selby chose a beautiful spot under giant sycamore figs and leadwood trees on the northern bank of the Khwai River. He also built his "bridge over the River Khwai", which today serves as the North Gate entrance to Moremi Game Reserve.

Moremi is exceptional for year-round game viewing. No fences are allowed in the reserve, so animals roam freely according to seasonal migration patterns. Come with us on a wealth of adventures ranging from early-morning game drives to moonlight safaris and stargazing excursions. Just six passengers travel in each vehicle, so everyone enjoys great views of the action.

Back at the lodge, round off a perfect day with a dip in the pool or a spa treatment, then join us for a buffet of delectable African specialities in Mothupi's Boma as a choir sings tribal songs.

Our traditional thatched rooms are built for game spotting. Spy wildebeest from the elevated private deck, or swing in a hammock as zebra and elephants saunter past. Inside, a netted four-poster bed, elegant bathroom, air conditioning and minibar all provide welcome refreshment after a day's pursuits.

Suite

For a more secluded and romantic experience, check into the private suite which is tucked away from the main rooms. Take a dip in the heated splash pool as antelope dash mere metres away. Or enjoy an alfresco shower at dawn to witness the savannah coming to life.

Restaurant





Currently we are able to offer what we classify as 'kosher light', which is our entry-level offering. Please note, if clients are strictly kosher this service may not be suitable. We offer a segregated kitchen area where we carefully separate the kosher food, cutlery, kitchen utensils and wash-up areas. We only buy Beth Din approved products. In the dining area there will be a reserved table for our kosher guests, who have the opportunity to liaise daily with our Executive Chef to discuss menus and dishes.

Game Drives

Our morning and afternoon game drives depart daily in open land cruisers. As our Lodge is located on a private concession, our vehicles are allowed to veer off-road, offering a freedom rarely experienced on other safaris. All year round you can expect to spot giraffe, buffalo, lion, leopard, cheetah and wild dogs.

Bush Sundowners and Night Drives

Another advantage of being on a private concession: we don't have to be off the roads by sunset. This means you can enjoy a refreshing sundowner in the bush before setting off on a heart-stopping night game drive in a vehicle fitted with spotlights.

Walking Safari

Get close to the wildlife on a Khwai River walk with one of our experienced guides; spot animal tracks, fantastic insects and other amazing sights. Walking safaris are rare and a benefit of being on a private concession. They also give you the chance to learn about our unique ecosystem.

Sustainable Safaris

In all of our lodges we give the utmost consideration to protecting Botswana's precious environment for generations to come

Low-energy consumption, responsible waste management and recycling or reusing of materials are all part of our environmental ethos. In our two newly designed lodges, Belmond Eagle Island Lodge and Belmond Savute Elephant Lodge, we've significantly reduced our footprint and installed state-of-the-art energy-efficient systems. Initiatives have included replacing all concrete structures with reclaimed timber and sustainable bamboo and introducing local thatch. We've installed LED-based lighting, thermodynamic geysers and heat pumps to supply hot water, and filtration and remineralisation plants to provide drinking water. Guests are given reusable water bottles to refill from the coolers. Kitchen waste is turned into compost, which is then used by community farming projects outside of the parks. At Belmond Savute Elephant Lodge, a Tesla Photo Voltaic Solar system, the first of its kind in Botswana, integrates with generators to ensure a single, uninterrupted power supply.




